Ms. LaDoux has worked for both state and local governments performing project management, construction inspection, and design roles. Working as a project manager she worked with contractors to ensure the project stayed on schedule and within the budget, made payments for work items, performed payroll tasks, ensured DBE requirements were being met, and finalized and closed out projects. Working in her role as an inspector, Ms. LaDoux oversaw operations on both bridge and roadway construction projects. Specific operations include concrete pours of bridge super and sub structure components, performed concrete testing procedures such as slump, temperature, and air content, cofferdam installations, BMP installations for erosion control, traffic control installations, roadway GAB placement and asphalt paving operations, as well as concrete roadway slab removal and replacement. In her design role Ms. LaDoux used her knowledge of bridge and roadway construction to design rehabilitation projects for bridges she was in charge of as well as pedestrian safety projects like sidewalk or PED crossings. She also produced bids and quantities for these projects. Ms. LaDoux also managed sections that were in charge of Land Development, Utilities, Surveying, ROW acquisition, and GIS mapping.
