Mr. Potter is an accredited traffic accident reconstructionist with extensive training and experience. He holds and maintains his reconstruction accreditation through the Accreditation Commission for Traffic Accident Reconstruction. His specific areas of expertise include vehicle collision reconstruction, auto-pedestrian and bicycle reconstruction, motorcycle reconstruction, commercial vehicle crash investigation and analysis, human factors in traffic collisions, vehicle safety systems, vehicle crash data, video analysis and forensic post collision vehicle examination.

Mr. Potter continues to conduct ongoing research with other nationally recognized experts in field and has been published in peer-reviewed literature with focus on vehicle crash data, identifying, quantifying and developing solutions for complex vehicle crash data retrieval and analysis issues. He has served as adjunct faculty for the Weber State University Police Academy, Tooele Technical College, and the Salt Lake City Police Academy teaching basic, intermediate and advanced accident investigation as well as accident reconstruction, emergency vehicle operations, special problems for collision investigations, and vehicle crash data retrieval.

Prior to his expert work in the private sector, he served as a Police Sergeant and Officer with the Salt Lake City Police Department for over 23 years and was the founding member of the county-wide crash investigation team (CAR ~ Collision Analysis Team) which received congressional recognition. During his tenure with the Salt Lake City Police Department, his primary focus was on collision investigation/reconstruction, DUI enforcement/interdiction, Police emergency vehicle operations and commercial motor vehicle safety and enforcement.

Mr. Potter has been utilized as an Accident Reconstruction Consultant / Expert for various Law Enforcement agencies including the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the United States Attorney's Office. Thomas has extensive experience testifying in criminal and civil cases, including providing expert testimony at trial.
